- 1. The Claimants seek an interim and final injunction pursuant to s.222 of the Local Government Act 1972 and/or s.187B of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 and/or s.1 of the Anti Social Behavior-Crime-and Policing Act 2014, with a power arrest attached to the appropriate provisions of the court order.
- 2. The Claimant owns a number of public parks, car parks and open spaces within its Borough, and has suffered a number of unlawful encampments throughout the last 2 years as detailed in the evidence. In addition, a number of privately owned commercial and similar sites have also been the subject of unlawful encampments in breach of planning control. The details of these and the impacts suffered by local businesses are contained in the witness statements attached to this claim form. The encampments have also impacted on nearby schools whose children have been intimidated and threatened by the Travellers children, as detailed in the witness evidence.
- 3. LBBD is a small borough, and has experienced significant and prolonged issued associated with unlawful encampments, including fly-tipping, anti-social behaviour, violent behaviour and public order problems. The Claimant has experience environmental and health risks associated with the encampments.
- 4. The encampments are having a detrimental impact on local business and enterprise, as well as on the enjoyment of public spaces. The impact on local businesses is detriment to the borough's future development and growth opportunities. Existing powers are being undermined and are ineffective, the law if being floated repeatedly and the Council has experienced significant expense both in legal costs and clear-up costs. Service of s.77 CJPOA 1994 orders only leads to the encampments moving from one site to the next and has not deterred the travellers from forming these encampments within the Borough.

- 5. For the reasons set out in the witness statements, it is necessary and expedient for the promotion and protection of the interests of the inhabitants of LBBD and to prevent further apprehended breaches of planning control and to prevent further acts of anti-social behaviour and to seek an injunction to prevent repeated establishment of unauthorised encampments.
- 6. It is necessary to bring these proceedings against persons unknown and to deter any unauthorised encampments on specified sites by such persons. It is not possible to identify all of the individuals who have formed part of these unauthorised encampments, many of whom are not prepared to identify themselves. The draft Order attached with this claim form recognises that a more limited order should be sought against Persons Unknown. Accordingly, the order sort confines the scope of the injunction against persons unknown to specified sites within the Borough.

ANY OTHER PERSON WHO KNOWS OF THIS ORDER AND DOES ANYTHING WHICH HELPS OR PERMITS THE DEFENDANTS TO BREACH THE TERMS OF THIS ORDER MAY ALSO BE HELD IN CONTEMPT OF COURT AND MAY BE IMPRISONED, FINED OR HAVE THEIR ASSETS SEIZED

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

Until further order the First to Sixty Fourth Defendants are forbidden from:

- 1. Setting up an encampment on any land within the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham unless authorised to do so by the owner of the land
- 2. Setting up an encampment on any land within the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham without written permission from the Local Planning Authority, or, planning permission granted by the planning inspector.
- 3. Entering and/or occupying any part of the Land for residential purposes (temporary or otherwise) including the occupation of caravans/mobile homes, storage of vehicles, caravans and residential paraphernalia.
- 4. Bringing on to the Land or stationing on the Land any caravans/mobile homes other than when driving through the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham or in compliance with the parking orders regulating the use of car parks or with the express permission from the owner of the land.
- 5. Deposit or cause to be deposited, controlled waste in or on the Land unless an waste management license or environmental permit is in force and the deposit is in accordance with the license or permit.

Until further order the Sixty Fifth Defendants are forbidden from:

- 6. Setting up an encampment on any land identified on the attached map and list of sites without written permission from the local planning authority, or, planning permission granted by a planning inspector
- 7. From entering and/or occupying any part of the land identified on the attached map and list of sites for residential purposes (temporary or otherwise) including the occupation of caravans/mobile homes, storage of vehicles, caravans and residential paraphernalia
- 8. From bringing onto the Land or stationing on the Land any caravans/mobile homes other than when driving through the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham or in compliance with the parking orders regulating the use of car parks or with express permission from the owners of the land.
- 9. Deposit or cause to be deposited, controlled waste in or on the Land unless an waste management license or environmental permit is in force and the deposit is in accordance with the license or permit.

The Land in this order means:

10. For the First to Sixty Fourth Defendants all land within the London Borough of Barking and Dagenham as appears within the marked black outline on the attached map at Schedule 1 of this Order.

- 11. For the Sixty Fifth Defendants (persons unknown) all the land marked on the map at Schedule 1 of this Order and identified by the key to the map and numbered 1 to 140, further details of which are on the list at Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 12. Service of this Order shall be by affixing a copy of this Order in a transparent envelope, or laminated copy, in a prominent position on the land.
- 13. The defendants may each of them (or anyone notified of this Order) apply to the Court on 72 hours written notice to the Court and the Claimant to vary or discharge this Order (or so much as if it affects that person)
- 14. The Defendant pay the Claimant's costs to be assessed at £

GUIDANCE NOTES

EFFECT OF THIS ORDER

- 15. A Defendant who is an individual who is ordered not to do something must not do it himself or in any other way. He must not do it through others acting on his behalf or his instructions or with his encouragement.
- 16. A Defendant which is a corporation and which is ordered not to do something must not do it itself or by its directors, officers, employees or agents or in any other way.

PARTIES OTHER THAN THE CLAIMANT AND DEFENDANTS

EFFECT OF THIS ORDER

17. It is a contempt of court for any person notified of this Order knowingly to assist in or permit a breach of this Order. Any person doing so may be sent to prison, fined, or have their assets seized.

INTERPRETATION OF THIS ORDER

- 18. In this Order, where there is more than one Defendant, unless otherwise stated, references to "the Defendants" means each or all of them.
- 19. A requirement to serve on "the Defendants" means on each of them, unless an Order of the Court specifies otherwise. The Order is, however, effective against any Defendant on whom it is served.
- 20. An Order requiring the Defendants to do or not to do anything applies to all Defendants.
- 21. "controlled waste" has the same meaning as within s.75(4) of the Environmental Protection Act 1990


